He will be formally appointed to the Secretary Treasurer post by the NMID Board of Directors at its meeting set for 9 a.m. on August 4 at the NMID offices in Nampa.

Comeskey holds a Master of Business Administration from Boise State University and a Bachelor of Science in Biology from Washington State University. He grew up in Washington state and has lived in the Treasure Valley for 13 years. He is married with two sons, who are 10 and 12.

Comeskey replaces Daren Coon who is retiring after 44 years with the District. Coon will remain with the District through the end of the year serving as an advisor to his successor and the NMID Board of Directors.
